



What makes OnGuard different?

OnGuard is specially designed and formulated with the health and safety of your loved ones in mind. OnGuard not only offers protection from stains to your furniture, but it uniquely offers protection from harmful asthma-triggering microbes and bacteria that thrive in high-traffic areas, like family living rooms. OnGuard is a water based, environmentally friendly treatment that is kind to people, pets and the planet.

What is in OnGuard?

All elements within the OnGuard treatment are water based and do not contain PFOA and PFOS chemicals. The medical grade antimicrobial/antibacterial treatment has been certified by Oeko-Tex®, Bluesign® and the EPA - USA.

Which fabrics can be treated?

Most Warwick and Linia woven fabrics can be treated with the OnGuard formula, even light coloured or natural fibre textures. Your design aesthetic doesn't need to be limited by practicality!

How is OnGuard applied?


Fabric is fully immersed into a bath of unique OnGuard solution, and then put through rollers to ensure that the fabric is fully impregnated. The fabric is dried and cured to cross link both the repellency and health chemistry. The OnGuard treatment will add approx. 15 working days to the delivery of your fabric.

How do I spot clean my OnGuard treated fabric?

Treat spills and stains as soon as possible! Gently scrape any soil or mop any liquid from the surface of the fabric. Use a white cloth moistened with water to <u>lightly</u> dab away any stain. Do not saturate the fabric or interior with water or other cleaning liquids. If needed, apply a gentle fabric cleaner to the area, like the Halo Spot Cleaner, to remove stubborn stains.

When in doubt, try our Halo Care Kit!

The Halo Fabric Care Kit includes a Halo Spot Cleaner for removing most household stains, Halo Fabric Deodoriser to help neutralise pet and general odours, and Halo Fabric Protector to restore liquid repellency on fabric sections that have been spot cleaned. The Halo Fabric Care Kit is available from most furniture suppliers.



How long does OnGuard last?

Generally the OnGuard treatment will last 4-5 professional cleans, when cleaned in accordance with our care label and cleaning instructions. We recommend professional cleaning every two years.

What is the warranty for OnGuard?

Five years for residential applications, three years for commercial applications.
